Celebrating Home and Community

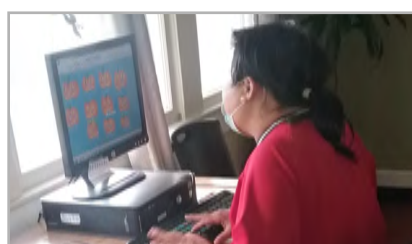
